ABSTRACT

Aim of the Study: This research study is exploring the Teen Nick TV program's thematic analysis broadcast for adolescents during 2009 to 2023.

Methodology: The researcher has adopted content analysis and textual analysis method to investigate the themes of Teen Nicks programs. The uses and gratification theory has been used to investigate thematic frame.

Findings: The thematic analysis results have revealed that Teen Nicks Children TV program shows presented teenagers indulging in trivial matters of everyday life like friendship, music & dance rehearsals, learning a new skill, app designing, problem solving, heroic action and adventure etc.

Conclusion: Study concluded frightful situation that future generation minds are diluted instead of informative or thought provoking content. They are entertained by trivial and ridiculous program themes.

Introduction

1n 1940s, TV was launched this instrument became the part of house hold very rapidly, 55% houses had television in their homes by the end of 1954 (Pecora, 1998). The first children entertainment program "Muppet Muffin" was broadcasted in 1947 (Hollis, 2001). Primarily; Children TV programs were produced for the entertainment and shortage of broadcast content (Palmer and McDowell, 1981).

Teen Nick is a block of Nickelodeon and subsidy of Viacom. It re-broadcast Nickelodeon series and acquired programs from different channels. Teen Nick programing is targeted on tweens and teen agers (Seidman, 2015). Teen Nick hurled on April1, 2002, as a Night Time programming block on "The N", from 6:00 p.m to 6:00 a.m. on a weekly schedule (Sarah, 2006).

In 2009, Nickelodeon transformed 'The N 'block into Teen Nick. Further; In September 28, 2009, the channel officially established as Teen Nick in the opening broadcasted all that "The Nick Nickelodeon series" (Hill, 2019). The N blocks programming shifted to Teen Nick except a few programs like; 'The Best Years Degrassi', 'The Next Generation', and 'The Assistants'. In 2010, Teen Nick introduced to air music videos in morning and afternoon slot. More they started to broadcast commercials during program

Published: June 30, 2023 intervals (Reynolds, 2010). Teen Nick carries a slogan "Best Week Ever". It broadcast in USA, Neither land, Belgium, India, Mexico, Israel, Italy, Africa and South East Asia (Wikipedia).

The channel has a tradition to broadcast during 6:00 to 10:00 pm ET. A popular programing block, The Splat' broadcast during 10:00 pm to 10:00 am ET. Teen Nick is popular for its non –violent and entertaining programing (Seidman, 2015). In 2011, Teen Nick started to air, 'The 90's Are All That', block these shows were selected from Nickelodeon popular shows from 1990s targeted at tweens and teen audiences. In 2014, Teen Nick started thematic holiday programming during holiday seasons of the year (Brain, 2015). In 2015, "The 90's Are all that" block was converted into "The Splat" again and presented shows from the 1980's, and early -2000s .The block airs during 10:00 pm to 2:00 am, and repeats from 2:00am to 6:00 am in the morning (Steinberg, 2015).

Literature Review

Reimer (1995) describes that teen's TV viewing results in cultivating mental peace, calmness and composition to sit peacefully in front of TV. They make a strong bonding with their peers in search of a entertaining TV shows.

Cote & Allahar (1996) identified that the fantasy and fictional program themes presented from TV effects the critical thinking of children & teen. The development of critical thinking is very essential for the progress of problem solving skill for individual and collective role of children in a society.

Okoro (2008) investigated the distinctive effects of TV on teen described that most of the shows teen view are enjoyable like; 'movies, musical videos, soap operas', etc. The effects of TV programs on teen are not immediate and similar due to various factors associated with TV watching practice like; family norms, socio economic status, cognitive development and psychology of individuals.TV watching habits can cultivate a fantasized world, and immoral values. However; TV watching habit enhances the global perspective and vision. The results depends on programs selection these teen selects for watching.TV watching habit is providing implication of TV programs in real life. It's providing a life script and making their life more colorful and entertaining. If they are lacking due to any factor, by following media script, they can keep balance in their life in accordance with societal norms.TV instructs and guards youngsters about the accepted and prohibited behavior of the society.

Pehlke, Hennon, Radina, & Kuvalanka (2009) reported that they have investigated the sitcoms presented the themes of family life and fathers role in a family. They have concluded that most of the sitcoms themes represented fathers role involved in different activities, both positive and negative traits were attached with the head of the family. All the shows addressed the themes that it's difficult to perform the duty and role as a father in a contemporary family's. Although; nobody is willing to acknowledge and admit his role as a father. The empirical researches couldn't define the parameters of ideal fatherhood characteristics and role. However, children expectations with father role and the impact of father's role should be examined in relation of family, community, culture and history (Cabrera, Tamis-LeMonde, Bradley, Hofferth, & Lamb, 2000, p. 133).

Donohue & Swords (2022) explored that children TV programs are major subscriber to the identification of mental illness and considering it a stigma to eliminate for a healthy life. They have studied the children TV programs on Netflix their themes & characters labeled as obsessive and psychotic. A descriptive thematic analysis was conducted over 40 popular children TV programs with mental illness. They have discovered almost 118 characters labeled as suffering from mental illness in 58% programs. These characters were represented impolite like "foolish," "senseless," and "cracked". Mostly these characters had inclination to criticize and condemn other people behaviors. The mental illness was measured through the parameters of unpredictable behavioral traits, untrustworthy, violence, fear and avoidance of behavior. Male characters were challenging to treat for protagonist before climax in TV programs. These themes and characters produced negative stigma for children suffering from mental illness.

Study Objectives

- 1. To explore the number of programs broadcasted by Teen nick during 2009 -2023.
- 2. To analyze the themes broadcast by Teen Nick for the entertainment of teen.

Hypothesis

It's more likely that Teen Nick has aired programs themes about a fictional and fantasized world.

Rationale of the Study

Tragically a limited TV entertainment programs are available for teen all over the world. The Imperialism of few media conglomerates over children entertainment industry is threatening. The far reaching negative effects of children entertainment industry are influencing the future generation, their minds and behaviors for commercial pursuits. The importance and effects of children television programs in progress and deterioration of teen's behavior, intellect and moral values. This research study can prove valuable to bring positive implications in themes production by introducing more informative, thought provoking ethical and morale programs for teen. Teen age girls and boys are considered heavy TV viewers as compared to other age groups. They are highly dependent on TV for entertainment, emotional and intellectual development similarly. In light of this research a policy and agenda can be designed for teen's emotional and intellectual requirements that should be addressed in TV shows.TV program themes should be produced vigilantly to prepare teen for the life challenges, they will have to face in contemporary urban life and future.

Theoretical Framework

This research is founded in uses and gratification theory. This theory states that mass media is gratifying social and emotional needs (Blumer, Gurevitch & Katz, 1974). The philosophy of uses and gratification is rooted in the opinion of Herzog (1944). The uses and gratification theory bestows the privilege and direction for audiences to understand the process of mass media. She has reported that TV watching activity results in balancing of emotions, inspire, directs and amuse them. The uses and gratification are founded in accordance with a human's social and psychological need. An individual's interacts with a larger community through mass media. The programs scripts, theme, characters, production and distribution techniques are full filling different human and psychological needs in distinct manner (Bulmer & Katz, 1974).

Every individual is consuming mass media for a variety of purposes (West & Turner, 2007). A person indulges in TV watching activity for escaping from dark realities of life, real identity, exploration, surveillance, and relationship with a larger community through TV medium (McQuail, 1972). Another purpose of mass media activity is to depart from unwanted relations and connections around (Katz et al, 1973). The basic function of mass media is to create social & cultural linkages, education and entertainment (Rubin, 1981; West Turner, 2007, P 426). The viewer can easily select shows according to their interest, need, desire and mood of that day. They can easily identify and rank programs (West & Turner, 2007). The societies spend time in front of TV to fulfill their emotional and psychological needs (Lariscy et al, 2011).

Research Methodology

The researcher has adopted content analysis method to find the results of this study. A coding sheet was designed according to the objectives of this research study. The researcher has collected the data about the number of broadcast Teen Nick TV programs since its establishment to 2023. The researcher has adopted the non-probability sampling method, 10% most popular Teen Nicks TV shows thematic analysis is investigated and presented in this study. The program titles were shortlisted according to the rating and popularity from bellow mentioned web portals.

The data was collected from following websites: 'www.commonsense.com, www.wikipedia.com, www.IMDb.com, TV tropes.com, www.wikifandom.com, www.tvdb.com, www.rotten tomatoes.com, www.youtube.com,www.netflex.com'.

The investigator has adopted textual analysis method for the exploration of Teen Nicks TV shows thematic analysis. 'Textual analysis is a method of study utilized by researchers to examine messages as they appear through a variety of mediums. The data generated for textual analysis can come from documents, films, newspapers, paintings, web pages, and so forth. These forms of data serve as the "texts" under study and are used to assess the meanings, values, and messages being sent through them' (Smith, 2017).

Thematic coding is a method of qualitative analysis which comprises record or identifying passages of text or images that are related by a common theme or idea allowing you to index the text into categories and establish a framework of thematic ideas about it (Gibbs 2007).

There are different approaches' to conduct content analysis. Commonly it consist on six step; familiarization, coding, generating themes, reviewing themes, defining and naming themes, writing up (Caulfield, 2022).

Thematic coding is descriptive and helps in categorization of things and ideas. This research thematic frame is based on familiarization and reviewing of themes. The first ground analyzed the popular Teen Nicks TV Programs themes according to rating. The second categorization is constructed on reviewing and conducting textual analysis of program themes then defining and writing up about presented themes (Caulfield, 2022).

The basis of this thematic analysis is to explore Teen Nick TV programs themes broadcasted during (2009-2023). Teen Nick's programs thematic analysis will help in inferring the opinion about themes. They can be appreciated or criticized due to the importance of this medium for teens. The teens programming plays very important role for the next generations character building. The positive and negative contents have far reaching impact on minds and behaviors. This thematic analysis will bring improvement in production and distribution. Descriptive method was adopted for the presentation of thematic analysis of results. Only 10 % Teen Nicks programs thematic analysis is included in this research for inferring results.

Results / Findings

A Thematic Analysis of Teen Nick Children TV Programs

Teen Nick has broadcast programs for teenagers aged 13-19 years old. This research opened that Teen Nick has broadcast total 262 number of programs during 2009- 2023. The researcher has included 10 % broadcast programs thematic analysis in this study, shortlisted by using popularity index from different web archives rating. The thematic analysis has revealed that following TV program themes have been broadcasted for the entertainment of teen.

ICarly

The series presents I Carly a stylish girl, living with her 26 years old brother in Seatle. Her father is a U.S air force officer on a submarine. I Carly and her friends used to do rehearsal for school talent show. A boy

mischievously records the rehearsal and uploads it online. This shared video got viral among viewers and transformed I Carly and her friends into celebrities. The series has broadcast the themes like music contests, ex-positional, problem solving, and dance competitions.

Victorious Comedy

The series presents the themes of family gatherings, romance, comedy and music. Toni Vega is 16 years old, main protagonist of this show victorious. She is the one of 8 main characters and one of four main characters that appear in each episode .She is trying to get free from suppression of her elder sister dominance and control. Toni Vega got chance to join "Hollywood Arts" where she will be able to practice, acting, singing and dancing. Before joining, she was unaware about her inner talent. Now she is quickly learning how things work at Hollywood Arts School.

The Amanda Show

Its action comedy and variety show and spin-off of All that'. Amanda Byne is the host of the show, program set in a fantasy world. The show provides variety of scripts; a character appears frequently,' Penelope Taint' a leading fan of Amanda. Each episode presents Penelope struggling to meet and communicate Amanda and failed.

Big Time Rush

The band consists of four real-life best friends who were hockey performers from Minnesota named Kendall Schmidt, James Maslow, Carlos Pene Jr. and Logan Henderson. They aim to launch a boy band Kendal. If you will watch the show Big Time Rush, Logan is the smartest in the show. They board on a life changing voyage and confront different trails alongside the way. At the Kid's Choice Awards held in Australia in 2010, the band was considered for the nomination of Most Popular International Band.

How to Rock

How to Rock is an American comedy and adolescent sitcom TV series. It presents a popular star singer Cymphonique Miller. The protagonist in How to Rock is Kacey Simon. Kacey was once a selfish, mean and unkind popular girl, whose status goes down and everyone started to hate her later. Bothered by associates for wearing braces and spectacles. After discovering this reality her friends dump her because they were afraid that being seen with her will ruin their reputation too.

The fact opened the eyes of Kacey that they are not her real friends. Kacey was shunned by the other nasty girls, finds a new outlet via music when she joins Steve Baskera, Zander Robbins, Nelson Baxter, and Kevin Reed to form the pop/hip band gravity 4. He wants to become DJ is slightly intolerable according to his personality. At the end of the day he's a good boy who cares about his friends. Simon is the smartest, cautious and a computer whiz. They came for their U.S tour but because of their adventurous personalities, entered into a music competition "Appollo Amature". They were shortlisted for the final competition due to their impressive performance, they indulge into an accident with the governing champ.

NSFW: Nick Shows were Freakin' Weird

The program has presented 90's 'Nickelodeon programs' that you have watched in your childhood, while growing. It has combined 'Nick Splat Nickelodeon's' late-night transmission that was comprise over Nickelodeon popular cartoons and live-action programs. Each show has a unique topic for the selection of programs to entertain the young teens from Nickelodeon 90s classics.

My Life as a Teenage Robot

The comedy series is presenting Robots in a fictional town. The story evolves around teen age issues and their encounter with magical creatures. The series presents XJ-9 a very civilized automatic robot girl manufactured by her mother Dr. Nora Wakeman, a renowned robotic scientist. The X_9 was created five years earlier the series broadcast. This robotic character X_9 is called jenny. She is upgraded with a large range of arms and war tactics. She is assigned the role to protect the earth. Although; she is technologically empowered to face any challenging situation but she presents herself as a normal teen in front of public. She presented accompanied with eight other models companions.

Back at the Barnyard

The comedy series is incarnation of 2006 film Barnyard. The program theme presents the life of farm animals Otis and his pals adventures. They go for adventure each day with a mission to have a thrilling day with their anthropomorphic identity hidden. They have fun in absence of other farm animals. The Otis is a cow and leader of the group makes plan with a mouse named sidekick pip .Their actions are a great source of laughter for other farm animals. Mostly Smart-mouthed Bessy gives the best idea to come out of difficult situations while Freddy the Ferret and Peck the Rooster never have a dull moment.

America's Funniest Home Videos

The show is popular as Americas Funnies Videos (AFV). The show presents funny homemade videos provided by audiences to the channel. They upload their funniest videos on channels website. Mostly show present videos related to accidental physical comedy, marriage proposals, funny kids talents, animal or kids, and staged funny foolery. It started in 1989 later broadcast weekly episode till 1990. Firstly; the show was hosted by Bob Saget for the first eight seasons. Later'John Fugelsang and Daisy Fuentes both took over as co-host for its ninth and tenth seasons'. It hunched broadcasting in 2015 and restarted in 2018. It presented the quarantine instruction during Covid -19 period titled as **AFV@Home**. In 2021, AFV was renewed for a 32nd season. The provided videos were graded between 1-10, and forwarded to the producers. The producer finally select with the help of another senior producer for final broadcast. They had the policy not to accept videos for broadcast about stage accidents, serious injuries, and the animal abuses.

The Bureau of Magical Things

The series was presented in real and magical world simultaneously.
