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Image Portrayal of States and Societies in Pakistani and Indian Films

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ABSTRACT

The basic purpose of this research article is to analyze the image of Pakistan and India portrayed by each other in their films. The article focuses on how the films are being used by the both countries to portray each other either in positive or negative way. Study used the mixed method i.e., quantitative and qualitative by its nature and data collected from online archive of countries' films having the theme of image portrayal of neighbor country i.e., Pakistan and India. A list of films of both the countries since 1948 till now is drawn. A general data about films collected through internet. Study found that in majority films of both countries showing each other enemy. The study also highlighted religious, cultural and social aspects of films. It is concluded that Indian films portraying Islam and Muslims in a negative way.

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Introduction

A film, sometimes known as a movie, is a collection of still photos on film that are projected in fast succession onto a screen using light. The motion picture is an incredibly effective medium for expressing drama and, more importantly, for evoking emotion. Motion films are extremely complicated, involving contributions from practically every other creative form as well as a wide range of technical skills, such as sound recording, photography, and optics. This new art form emerged at the end of the nineteenth century and quickly became one of the most popular and important media of the twentieth century and beyond.

The optical phenomenon known as persistence of vision is used to create the appearance of motion movies. The cheapest form of entertainment, cultural projection, and socializing is motion pictures.

The motion picture prospered as a mass media centred on theatrical presentation in the first half of the twentieth century. Attending movies became a social activity that could be done with friends or in a crowd of strangers. New technologies have enabled a wide range of watching options by the end of the twentieth century, ranging from a single spectator to audiences of thousands in a single place or millions across several venues. In 1891, 'Thomas Alva Edison' and 'William Dickson' invented the Kinetoscope, the first motion-picture viewing apparatus. It only enabled one spectator at a time to peek through a peephole at the machine's small moving images.

Pakistan-India Relations

Due to a variety of historical and political events, relations between Pakistan and India have been complicated and largely antagonistic. The violent partition of British India in 1947, the Kashmir war, and multiple military conflicts between the two countries have all shaped relations between the two countries. As a result, their relationship has been marred by suspicion and resentment.

The relationship between India and Pakistan has had more lows than highs. Since its 70 years of independence, the bittersweet relationship between the two countries has made no meaningful development or accomplished any big breakthrough.

Pakistan and India have an odd relationship that alternates between periods of calm and periods of strife. Both sides' depiction in the media has tended to aggravate rather than resolve difficulties. The Indian media has been accused of disseminating anti-Pakistan propaganda and presenting a skewed picture of the situation. Both the Indian and Pakistani media have been accused of pushing their own agendas based on their own self-interests.

Role of Media

As stated by Jim Morrison:

"Whoever controls the media, controls the mind."

Media is now a crucial part of our lives, and it plays a significant influence in almost every aspect of our lives. It connects us to global events and informs us about a variety of topics such as news, history, and entertainment, all of which contribute to our development as individuals. Peace media, according to Father of Peace Johan Galtung, is described as the use of media for the promotion of peace and to transform public ideas and sentiments toward peaceful conflict resolution. They can also support peace projects.

Media is playing a dual role in promoting the relationship between India and Pakistan. Media has religious, cultural and social aspects.

People from different countries should separate their feelings of love and hatred. In this regard, the media can play an important role in bringing the two countries closer together.

Besides this a war of words erupts on live television programs and each side blames the other for the impasse. A media should try to minimize the heat between the two countries. Both the Pakistani and Indian media had initiated campaigns to malign each other's image. And this can also be seen in their films. Through their films they are trying to instill in the people's mind that we are enemies from day one.

Methodology

The researchers used content analysis method to conclude the study. The data was collected from online archive and films of both countries from 1947 to 2010 were taken. The study was census and all films having the concept of image building of neighbor country were taken.
